## Highlights

- An enhanced data management system which captures individual client data and program data is critical for documentation of interventions and outcomes and is instrumental to ongoing evaluation activities.
- The migration of a data capture system requires a thorough assessment of program needs, stakeholder buy-in, and knowledge of system specifications and capabilities.
