**Definitions:**

Prevention Level	Definition
<b>Contextual / Primary</b>	Prevent the emergence of social and environmental conditions that can lead to diseases
<b>Secondary</b>	Detect and treat diseases in early stages
<b>Tertiary</b>	Alleviate the effects of disease

Intervention Level	Definition
<b>Public Policy</b>	Local, state, and national laws and policies
<b>Community</b>	Relationships among organizations, Institution, and informal networks within defined boundaries
<b>Organizational</b>	Social institutions with organizational characteristics and from (and informal) rules and regulations for operation
<b>Interpersonal</b>	Formal and informal social network and social support systems including family, work group and friendship networks
<b>Individual</b>	Characteristics of the individual (knowledge, attitudes, behavior, self-concept, skills, etc.). Includes the individual's developmental history
